Parents/ Guardians:

The Clay County Public Health Center is receiving 2009 H1N1 vaccine shipments. We are partnering with the Kearney School District to make vaccine more easily available to Clay County children. We plan to offer a school based clinic for Kearney School District only on **Monday November 23rd from 4:00pm – 7:00pm** at the Kearney High School, Kearney, MO and **only for the CDC identified high risk groups listed below.**

Current high risk categories identified by CDC are:

- **pregnant women**
- **Household contacts and caregivers who live with infants aged less than 6 months**
- **children aged 6 months to 18 years old**

PARENTS MUST ACCOMPANY THEIR CHILDREN TO RECEIVE THE VACCINE

There is no charge for the vaccination

The following forms will be available at Monday's clinic. To save time they can also be downloaded in advance from our website <http://www.clayhealth.com>

- 1. Parental consent form. The forms must be signed and completed no earlier than three days before the clinic. Bring the forms with your child to the clinic.**
- 2. Vaccine Information Statement for all formulations. Please read it prior to clinics and signing the consent form.**

[If you do not meet the high risk criteria identified above for this Monday's clinic, please be assured that as more vaccine becomes available, more public clinics will be scheduled soon.
