

Vehicles/Parking 2009-10

All students who plan to park on Kearney High School grounds are expected to pay the vehicle registration fee. Cost of the fee is \$40.00. The registration fee is paid on a yearly basis and is not refundable. It may be paid on the designated days for student schedule pick up in August or in the office starting August 10, 2009, according to parking availability and student eligibility. A registration tag will be issued to each student who pays the fee.

Tags serve as proof of vehicle registration and must be openly displayed in the vehicle's front windshield. The tag is valid when displayed in the vehicle(s) to which it is registered. Students who are issued a registration tag are expected to maintain eligibility for parking on the KHS campus based upon regular punctuality and attendance, no outstanding fines/obligations, and generally following school rules.

Any student with an obligation will not be permitted to pay the vehicle registration to park on the KHS campus and/or an obligation invalidates a parking tag until the obligation is cleared. PARKING IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT! Any student may lose this privilege, without a refund, if he/she abuses school rules.

Although The Kearney R-I School District will seek to maintain the safety of the vehicle and its contents, authorized students are responsible for their vehicles and /or vehicle contents while parked on district grounds. No three or four-wheeled off-the-road or ATV type vehicles are permitted on school grounds.

Students are expected to drive responsibly and to follow parking rules including displaying a parking tag at all times and parking in the designated student parking areas. A student who parks in an unauthorized space may lose his/her driving-parking privileges for a period of time and/or have his/her vehicle towed away at his/her expense. In addition, expected responsible behavior includes planning ahead to arrive at school early enough to be in class on time. The accumulation of tardies to school and/or truancy may result suspensions or revocation of parking privileges.

The parking tag is the property of Kearney High School. An additional fee will be assessed for any lost or damaged permit. All tags must be returned upon the student's withdrawal from Kearney High School. Students/Families may not give/sell the tags to other students. The vehicle registration fee/tag is valid for the 2009-10 school year.

To obtain a vehicle registration tag, students must present/complete/meet the following criteria:

- 1) Complete Vehicle Registration form including student and parent signatures
- 2) Show valid Driver's License
- 3) Be a qualified and eligible KHS student
- 4) Be obligation free
- 5) Pay \$40 vehicle registration fee

If a student loses a tag, the replacement fee is Full Price.

Students who lose a Reserved tag may replace the tag with a regular student parking tag for Full Price.

The individual student driver is responsible for:

- Accurately registering all vehicles the student may park on campus with the school. The vehicle registration fee of \$40 may be paid in the high school office. The \$40 fee covers all vehicles a student might park on campus.
- Notifying the office whenever there is a change in the registered vehicle information.
- Relinquishing the parking permit at the request of an administrator.
- Knowing and observing the school's parking policies.
- Driving safely and with regard for the safety of others. Driving over curbs, on grassy areas or other unsafe types of driving can result in the loss of the parking permit.
- Observing the 15 mph speed limit and all parking lot patterns, school rules and regulations.
- Locking his/her vehicle.
- Not using tobacco products on the parking lot, in the vehicle, or on any part of school grounds.
- Having a pass signed by an administrator to go to his/her vehicle during the school day.
- Always displaying tag when parked on campus.
- Not parking in the faculty lot from 6:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
- Parking in the designated marked spots. Parking illegally in a yellow-marked area, fire zone, visitor, teacher or reserved spot may result in detentions, suspensions, parking tag suspended or revoked, and/or towing of the vehicle. There are no warnings for non-tagged vehicles.
- Understanding that parking in a handicapped zone could result in a ticket issued by the Kearney Police as well as disciplinary consequences being assigned by the school.
- Abiding by the vehicle regulations when riding a motorcycle on campus.

A vehicle is in violation of school policy if it is:

- Using more than one parking spot.
- Parked in a space that is not designated for the student vehicle.
- Parked outside designated parking spaces.
- Driven carelessly.
- Driven by a student whose registered parking tag is not registered to the vehicle he/she is operating.
- Driven by a student whose driving privilege is suspended.
- Parked in handicapped areas, fire lanes, faculty/staff/visitors parking areas, loading zones, along curbs, in aisles, or at the end of a row outside a designated space.
- Parked on campus without displaying a current Kearney High School parking registration tag in the appropriate area of the vehicle.

(The degree of seriousness will be considered.)

School Consequences:

- 1st Offense:** Written warning
- 2nd Offense:** Written reprimand; administrative conference
- 3rd Offense:** Written reprimand; loss of parking privilege up to 5 school days
- 4th Offense:** Written reprimand; loss of parking privilege for 10 school days; contact parents
- 5th Offense:** Written reprimand; vehicle towed; loss of parking privilege for 45 school days; contact parents
- Subsequent Offenses:** Written reprimand; vehicle towed; parking privilege revoked for 90 school days; contact parents

An administrator may withdraw a student's privilege to use the school parking facilities and/or may have a student's vehicle towed at the owner's expense for repeated parking violations. The school may also have a motor vehicle removed at owner's expense if it is necessary for the safety of the school.

Attentions Drivers:

A student's vehicle registration tag may be revoked for failure to drive safely, improper parking, failure to display appropriate registration tag, owing an obligation, truancy and/or excessive tardies to school.

This signed form and tag are valid for the 2009/10 school year only. Please hang tag on front windshield mirror of the vehicle parked on campus.

I will respect the rights of others and follow all school guidelines while driving/parking on the Kearney R-I School grounds. These include but are not limited to:

- Accurately registering my vehicle(s) with the school. I may pay my vehicle registration fee of \$40 per year in the KHS office. It may be used in any vehicle that I have properly registered in the KHS office.
- Parking on campus while properly displaying a current Kearney High School vehicle registration tag.
- Notifying the office whenever there is a change in the registered vehicle information.
- Relinquishing the vehicle registration tag at the request of an administrator.
- Knowing and observing the school's parking policies.
- Driving safely and demonstrating regard for the safety of others. I understand that driving over curbs, on grassy areas or other unsafe types of driving can result in the loss of the parking tag.
- Observing the 15 mph speed limit and all parking lot patterns, school rules and regulations.
- Locking my vehicle.
- Refraining from using tobacco products on the parking lot, in the vehicle, or on any part of school grounds.
- Having a pass signed by an administrator to go to my vehicle during the school day.
- Always displaying the vehicle registration tag when parked on campus.
- Refraining from parking in the faculty lot from 6:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
- Parking in the appropriate student-designated spots. I understand that parking illegally in a yellow-marked area, fire zone, visitor, teacher or reserved spot may result in detentions, suspensions, parking tag suspended or revoked, and/or towing of the vehicle. I also understand there are no warnings for non-tagged vehicles.
- Understanding that parking in a handicapped zone could result in a ticket issued by the Kearney Police as well as disciplinary consequences being assigned by the school.
- Abiding by the vehicle regulations when riding a motorcycle on campus.
- Using one parking spot.
- Using registration tag assigned to the vehicle I am driving.
- Understanding that I may not park a vehicle on school grounds if my privilege has been suspended.
